

Partner Carol O'Keefe spoke with Bloomberg Law on a first-of-its-kind ruling by the Fourth Circuit affirming a divestiture order for doormaker Jeld-Wen. The case marked the first time a merger was reversed by a claim brought by a private plaintiff rather than by a government regulator.

O'Keefe notes that the ruling makes claims for injunctive relief in private merger challenges "much more powerful. The availability of this as a private remedy was open to debate, and having a circuit court rule on it is really significant."


